DAUGHTERS OF AMERICAN REVOLUTION (DAR) AMERICA 250 PATRIOT MARKER TO BE ADDED TO AVM

The Anthem Community Council proudly announces the DAR America 250 Patriot marker will be permanently displayed at the AVM. The marker will be presented and donated by the local DAR Ocotillo Chapter. Currently, only one other marker has been approved in Arizona which will be placed in Bolin Memorial Plaza, Phoenix.

The United States Congress established the United States Semiquincentennial Commission to plan nationwide observances of the 250th anniversary of the United States in 2026. The Commission aims to inspire all Americans to participate in the largest and most inclusive commemoration in our nation's history through local, state, national and international engagement.

As 2026 approaches, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) markers commemorating the men and women who achieved American independence will be across the country.

"The Ocotillo Chapter of the DAR is proud to join the AVM in commemoration of the 250th anniversary," notes Chapter Regent Jennifer Merrill. "Having an America 250 Patriot marker in Anthem includes the community in the wider country-wide celebrations by recognizing these Patriots, who fought so valiantly to found a new nation."

Tells Aaron Baker, Anthem Executive Director, "The addition of this marker is, indeed, a great honor. Our country's history is founded upon the patriots who fought for freedom. The marker at the AVM will help future generations learn even more about our military history. Thank you, DAR Ocotillo Chapter, for making history at the AVM."

The award-winning AVM was named an Arizona Landmark in May 2012. This will be the first national marker presented to the Memorial.
