HONORING OUR VETERAN FAMILIES

The Anthem Veterans Memorial (AVM) recognizes that with every veteran is a family who also sacrifices in support of that veteran's service.

The AVM understands it is the family who smiles encouragingly when the teenager arrives home from school to share the decision to enter the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Space Force or Coast Guard. It is the family who waits patiently for letters, emails and phone calls to arrive from far-away lands. It is the family who packs and unpacks to move from base to base throughout the course of service. It is the family who comforts each other during dark times. It is the family who remembers the loved one who made the ultimate sacrifice for our nation.

To honor the love, support and sacrifice of military families, five benches were placed outside the Circle of Honor during the original build. The benches, from left to right represent each service branch (USA, USMC, USN, USAF/USSF and USCG) and symbolize the families who serve and sacrifice with those in uniform.

The AVM is a place for quiet reflection and the benches serve as meaningful tributes to our veteran families. We hope, when you visit the AVM, you also remember the veteran families who serve and sacrifice our nation.

Please refrain from bringing food and drinks on the benches of the AVM.

During W.W. I, family members displayed service flags with a blue star for every immediate family member serving in the Armed Forces. The star's color was changed to gold if that family lost a loved one in the war. In 1917, when Grace Siebold's son was killed during W.W.I., she wanted to create a support system for grieving mothers in similar circumstances.

In 1928, the American Gold Star Mothers was officially incorporated. In 1936, Congress declared what was known as "Gold Star Mother's Day" to be the last Sunday in September. In 2011, President Obama amended the declaration, declaring the day to include families as well as mothers.
