BIRD FEEDERS AND FEEDING WILDLIFE

Arizona law (ARS 13-2927) prohibits feeding, attracting or enticing unwanted wildlife, except for birds and squirrels, into an area. While feeding birds is permissible, birdseed feeders in the Anthem Country Club community are strongly discouraged.

- Residents are encouraged to be good neighbors in considering whether and where to hang birdseed feeders.
- If hanging, birdseed feeders are limited to one in the rear yard only and must be a minimum of five feet from a party wall and view fences.
- Residents may place hummingbird feeders in the rear yard only and are encouraged to use feeders designed to prevent poaching of nectar by other bird species.
