

Policy Development and Implementation Committee

Committee Charter

Mission: The express purpose of the Policy Development and Implementation Committee shall be to provide policy development and implementation recommendations to the Board with respect to the Use Restrictions described in the Association's CC&R's, Article 3 and Addendum C and to assist the Board and other standing committees in implementing policy decisions.

- The Committee shall consist of a minimum of five (5) members and a maximum of twelve (12) members.

Specific tasks shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- Ascertain the homeowners' interests and issues with respect to the Association's Use Restrictions policies
- Recommend changes to existing policies, rules, regulations and documents
- Communicate policy issues and changes to homeowners
- Report to the Board at regularly scheduled Board meetings
