ANTHEM'S YOUTH COUNCIL TO HOST FREE TEEN MOVIE/GAME NIGHT, FEB. 20

Anthem, Ariz. – The Anthem Youth Advisory Council (AYAC) will host a free teens-only movie and game night, Feb. 20 at the ACC Community Center in Anthem. The event will feature the film “Jumanji” on the big screen. Doors will open at 6 p.m. for board games and Rock Wall climbing, and the movie will begin at 7 p.m.

Admission to the event is two or more canned goods per person. “We wanted to add a service component to our events,” said AYAC member Aidan McGirr. “It's incredible that we have the opportunity to do these things, but we also want to give back to those less fortunate than us.”

AYAC will have snacks/soda for purchase for \$1 per item. Attendees may bring bottles of water and are encouraged to bring blankets and pillows to sit on (no chairs are permitted on the gym floor for the movie).

“This event builds on the success of AYAC’s movie nights last year,” said Jenna Kohl, Community Executive Officer for the Anthem Community Council and AYAC advisor. “With two movie nights under their belts and attendance that surpassed expectations, we are excited to offer another year of programs for Anthem teens.”

AYAC consists of thirteen members, ages 12-18 yrs. Together, they learn how local government works and how community services are provided; raise awareness about the ACC, its mission and proposals among Anthem youth; share ideas about youth issues, needs and community enhancements; and develop leadership and operational skills and contribute to the future development and enhancement of Anthem.
