## **CALL TO ARTISTS: ACC, SONORAN ARTS LEAGUE PARTNER FOR SECOND EXHIBIT AT ANTHEM CIVIC BUILDING**

**Anthem, Ariz.** – “Art in Public Places” will continue at the Anthem Civic Building into 2017 as a partnership between the Anthem Community Council and the Sonoran Arts League. The juried exhibit of art will be selected from submissions received beginning Dec. 1 and displayed beginning Jan. 27.

Key criteria for interested artists:

- Art may be any two- or three-dimensional medium, with the exception of jewelry (there is space for approximately 60 pieces).
- Artwork must be original; up to four pieces may be entered per artist.
- Artists must be at least 18 years of age.
- Artists must be located in Anthem or any North Valley location.
- Amateur and professional artwork will be accepted.
- Pieces displayed may be for sale.
- Initial exhibit will run for four months (February through May).
- There is a \$25 non-refundable entry fee for submissions.

Artists may register to submit between Dec. 1 and Jan. 17 via the Sonoran Arts League website. Jury day is Jan. 19, with art hanging to take place Jan. 27. The current exhibit will remain open through Jan. 27.

“The inaugural exhibit this fall was met with a huge outpouring of interest, both from artists and the public,” said ACC Management Analyst Meghann Hill. “We are excited to continue that momentum into 2017.”
