INTERNET SAFETY IS TOPIC OF SEPTEMBER 18 ANTHEM NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PRESENTATION

Anthem, Ariz. – Mike Cassity, an Internet security professional, will address a number of issues relating to teen and parent Internet safety at a September 18, 7 p.m. presentation at the Anthem Civic Building, 3701 W. Anthem Way.

An information security operations specialist at a local corporation, Cassity holds three information security certifications: GIAC Certified Enterprise Defender, GIAC Security Essentials and CompTIA Security+.
