NATIONAL ANTHEM SOLOIST SOUGHT FOR JULY 3 INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

Anthem, Ariz. – Auditions will be held May 31 to select this year’s National Anthem performer for Anthem’s annual Independence Day Celebration. Auditions will begin at 6 p.m. at the Anthem Civic Building, 3701 W. Anthem Way.

Those interested must register to audition by May 19. The first 30 performers to register will receive an audition. Minors under the age of 18 yrs. must have signed consent; parents/guardians will not be allowed in the audition room.

Eligible candidates will sing solo and a cappella in front of a panel of volunteer judges. Groups will not be allowed to audition; individuals only. The piece must be memorized and performed in full. In order to be eligible, performers **MUST** be available for the Independence Day Celebration, July 3 from 6-10 p.m., at Anthem Community Park.

The Independence Day Celebration draws more than 20,000 attendees from Anthem and across the Valley. The event includes live music, food vendors, water slides and rides, and concludes with a fireworks show at 9:30 p.m. (weather permitting).
