Anthem Civic Building offers room rental orientation to public Feb. 4 Residents invited to learn about ACB room rental options

Anthem, Ariz. – The Anthem Community Council invites Anthem residents to attend a room rental orientation and facility tour of the new Anthem Civic Building on Tuesday, Feb. 4 at 7 p.m.

The FREE orientation will provide in-depth/“how-to” information to those who may be interested in scheduling meetings or events within the rentable room space at the Anthem Civic Building, 3701 W. Anthem Way.

Effective Feb. 3, the Anthem Civic Building will be open the following operating hours: Mon., Wed., Thurs, Fri., 7 a.m.-7 p.m.; Tues., 7 a.m.-9 p.m.; Sat., 7 a.m.-noon. The building is closed on Sundays.

The new Anthem Civic Building opened its doors to the public for the first time on Saturday, Jan. 25 to nearly 1,000 residents who turned out to enjoy a ribbon cutting and building dedication ceremony, and the kick off to Anthem’s 15th Anniversary celebration.

Also included in the day’s festivities were the dedication of a commemorative quilt, the installation of a time capsule, live music, a scavenger hunt, prize drawings, building tours, games, food, and give-aways to the first 100 attendees.

Known as “Anthem’s Living Room,” the multi-purpose building is intended to encourage and inspire social, cultural, civic, and educational interactions, while serving as a “hub” for all who visit.

In addition, it:

- Provides indoor and outdoor space for quiet recreational programs, classrooms, and other offerings
- Provides rental space for small and large community meetings and activities to facilitate meaningful and collaborative interaction
- Retains a strong and visible law enforcement presence within the boundaries of Anthem
- Houses Anthem Community Council and Homeowners Associations administrative services, and non-profit space
- Offers a variety of programming that will provide educational, creative, and fitness opportunities
- Features community art displays
