DLC Resources Donates Landscaping for Anthem Veterans Memorial

ANTHEM, ARIZ., June 21, 2011 – The Anthem Veterans Memorial Planning Committee announced today that DLC Resources, Inc., the common area landscape contractor for the Anthem Country Club Community Association properties, will provide the materials and labor for all landscaping needs associated with the Anthem Veterans Memorial.

“We at DLC Resources have a deep appreciation for veterans and the sacrifices that they made for our country,” says Jeff Penney, CEO of DLC Resources. “My dad hit Omaha Beach on D-Day +10 during World War II. Donating to the Anthem Veterans Memorial is our way of honoring and showing our gratitude to those who have served and preserved our freedom,” Penney continued.

The landscape plan for the Memorial site was designed to create intimacy for residents and visitors alike. Renee Palmer-Jones, designer and volunteer on the Memorial Planning Committee, notes, “The landscape plan mirrors the tranquility of the Memorial design. It is intentionally understated for visitors to reflect and remember those who serve our Nation, while maintaining the structural elegance and focal points of the aligned columns.”

DLC will plant nine Texas Mountain Laurel trees around the bench area to create a more private setting. They also will retro-fit the irrigation to the monument to minimize the water from spraying the monument and five surrounding benches. After the monument construction is complete, DLC will use overseeded sod on the resurfaced area.

The landscape installation will run concurrently with the timeline initiated by Haydon Building Corp, Memorial general contractors and Jim Martin, chief engineer and Memorial Planning Committee volunteer.

Says Ron Tucker, retired United States Navy Rear Admiral, “DLC was the first company to donate their services and we are thrilled to partner with them in this historic project in Anthem.”

At 11:11 a.m. on Veterans Day, the sun will pass through the openings to illuminate a mosaic of The Great Seal of the United States.
