ANTHEM SHOOT FOR DRUG AWARENESS 3-ON-3 EVENT OPEN FOR REGISTRATION

Anthem, Ariz. – The Anthem Drug Education Series will feature the Shoot for Drug Awareness 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament June 7 at the ACC Community Center gym, 41130 N. Freedom Way. The double elimination event will begin at 9 a.m. with games played to 11 points or 12 minutes, whichever comes first.

Age divisions are as follows: co-ed third and fourth graders; co-ed fifth and sixth graders; boys seventh and eighth graders; girls seventh and eighth graders; high school boys; and high school girls.


Winning team in each division will receive an \$80 gift card, with second place receiving a \$40 gift card. Team entry is \$40, which includes a t-shirt, bottled water and a snack.

Teen Challenge will participate, and will conduct a half-court contest with a prize giveaway to the winner. A MCSO SWAT and K-9 unit demonstrations will take place in the gym during the event, with their vehicles on display in the parking lot throughout the event for attendees to visit.
